Regional Tournaments – Qualifying Rounds

Each Region will organise its **own Regional Tournament**, in order to determine the positions of the teams in each age group that will qualify for the SACSSA National Six-a-Side Soccer Tournament.

These Result Forms must be completed by the <u>Regional Co-ordinator</u> and returned to the SACSSA National Office, <u>on or before Monday 12 May</u>

If the Form is submitted late, the **entries cannot be guaranteed**.

Guaranteed Regional Entries

Each Region is **guaranteed at least 1 team per age group**, with additional teams being drawn from the Reserve Teams.

Reserve Teams

Each Region must send through the names of as many positions, as possible, in each Age Group.

Provisional Entries

The Provisional Entries [reserves included], will be compiled and sent out **the day after the Due Date**

Gender

Schools are allowed to enter girls, in any of the teams, but this is <u>not recommended</u> for the Seniors, unless you have no other choice. Note that there is a <u>Girls only</u> group for the <u>Girls 19/u</u>

Change of Tournament Format

We are going to follow a new format this year, where every Age Group, will be divided into an A and a B Group. The A Group will play for medals and a trophy, while the B Group will play for certificates.

The A and B Groups will be determined based on the 2024 Results.

The Tournament will be divided into two parts:

- 1. The first part of the Tournament will be done in Round Robin Format.
- 2. The second part of the Tournament will consist of Knock-out matches.

Soccer Handbook

Included, please find the SACSSA Soccer Handbook, as compiled by Zachary Zwart.

This is a very useful document, which must be studied by everyone concerned with SACSSA Sixa-Side Soccer.

Entry Fee

As communicated by Regional co-ordinator.

Pavment

All fees have to be paid as one amount per school, into your own Regional Account.

All payments must be done as soon as the invoices are received

Provisional Time Schedule

08h00 - All teams and officials to report ± 17h00 – Completion

Detailed Programme

A detailed programme will be worked out, once all entries have been received.

Referees

One qualified/competent referee per team entered must be supplied. All Referees supplied by a school <u>must be approved</u> by the Regional Co-ordinator or Regional Soccer Co-ordinator

A maximum fee of **R400-00 per referee short** can be charged, for every referee that a school is short, although we do not expect any school to supply more than **3 qualified** referees. Additional approved referees, **if used**, will be remunerated.

Team List Form

The Team List Form will be sent out later

Please take note of the SACSSA rule, that a team may only consist of a maximum of 10 players and a minimum of 4.
