Regional Tournaments – Qualifying Rounds

Each Region will organise its own Regional Tournament, in order to determine the positions of the teams in each age group that will qualify for the SACSSA National Six-a-Side Soccer Tournament.

Guaranteed Regional Entries

Each Region is guaranteed at least 1 team per age group, with additional teams being drawn from the Reserve Teams.

Reserve Teams

Each Region must send through the names of as many positions, as possible, in each Age Group.

These Result Forms must be completed by the Regional Co-ordinator and returned to the SACSSA National Office, on or before Monday 25 May

If the Form is submitted late, the entries cannot be guaranteed.

Provisional Entries

The Provisional Entries [reserves included], will be compiled and sent out the day after the deadline date.

Gender

Schools are allowed to enter girls, in any of the teams. Note that there is a Girls only group for the Girls 13/u

Soccer Handbook

Included, please find the **SACSSA Soccer Handbook**, as compiled by Zachary Zwart.

This is a very useful document, which must be studied by everyone concerned with SACSSA Six-a-Side Soccer.

Entry Fee

The Entry Fee will be communicated by your regional co-ordinator.

Payment

All fees have to be paid as one amount per school, into your own Regional Account, within 3 days after receiving the invoice.

Provisional Time Schedule

08h00 - All teams and officials to report
± 17h00 – Completion

Detailed Programme

A detailed programme will be worked out, once all entries have been received.

Referees

One qualified/competent referee per team entered must be supplied. All Referees supplied by a school must be approved by the Regional Co-ordinator or Regional Soccer Co-ordinator

A maximum fee of R400-00 per referee short can be charged, for every referee that a school is short, although we do not expect any school to supply more than 3 qualified referees. Additional approved referees, if used, will be remunerated.

Team List Form

The Team List Form will be sent out with the Provisional Entries.

Please take note of the SACSSA rule, that a team may only consist of a maximum of 10 players and a minimum of 4.

A player may not represent 2 different Teams, during the same Tournament.
